- ◆ Skills and/or experience in the desired areas of expertise.
- ◆ Ability to constructively challenge the School leadership and work effectively with it to maintain and improve the excellent standards of the School.
- ◆ A genuine interest in education and its wider social and societal impacts.
- ◆ Proven abilities in objectivity and sound judgment.
- ◆ An interest in developing specific knowledge and understanding of the School and its community.
- ◆ Be an advocate of diversity and equal opportunities.
- ◆ Be able to work as a member of a team.
- ◆ Respect confidentiality.
- ◆ Have a willingness to learn and develop as a Governor/Committee Member through training and self-evaluation.
- ◆ Be willing to undergo student safeguarding screening.

Governors either have children attending the School or are fully independent.

The Committees also include members that are not members of the Board to ensure wider Committee expertise beyond the Board. The Committee members are parents of students attending St George's.

Governors and Committee Members are responsible for:

- ◆ Providing strategic direction for the School, in conjunction with the management.
- ◆ Challenging, supporting and monitoring the effectiveness of the School and its management.
- ◆ Ensuring the School development plan is effectively implemented.
- ◆ Overall responsibility and oversight of the School as a whole.
- ◆ Promoting diversity and equality in the School as a workplace.
- ◆ Supporting and promoting the School in its local and international community.
- ◆ Reviewing and approving the School's overall annual budget and school fees.
- ◆ Ensuring the safeguarding and promoting the welfare of its students.
